AAR topics of discussion:

- Guest Speaker – Over all Good; **Issue** – Continued to refine Vietnam presentations right up to program start. **Recommendation** – No presentation are planned for next year.
- Panel Question – Over all Good; Information flowed between panel and retirees. **Issues** – Feedback from retirees and vendors Q&A went too long; questions were asked without mic; personnel question(s) should be addressed off line. **Recommendations** – Try to capture questions up front, this has not been successful in past, tabled for further discussion at fall meeting; retiree council members assist FreeState in microphone delivery; stress to panel members to initially address personnel question and meet for one-on-one following panel discussion.
- Program Closing – Lost Control of target audience. **Issues** – Length of Q&A discussed above; Vietnam presentations discussed above and retirees setting for extend period of time. **Recommendation** – Chair manage program to within 5 minutes of schedule program; move Thank-You, raffle and lunch announcement to front of program following Invocation.
- VA Claims – Exceptional; VA team review and provide information to over 40 retirees.
- Lunch – Exceptional; 98 retirees/family members when through line.
- CY 16 Publicity - Exceptional; Mrs. West: Job well done!
- Tasker over the summer – Coordinate with AA Recreation Center for 12/13 May reservation (setup/program) – Mr. Palmer/Mr. Zalusky; Consider nomination for Guest Speaker - All
